Dear Silverado Family Member/Responsible Party,

As we mentioned in our last note, we will be continuing to update you regarding the planned Covid-19 vaccination clinics provided to our Residents and Associates.

We anticipate the first vaccination clinics being held in our communities before the end of the year, and it is possible as early as the week of Christmas.

So in light of the pandemic, there is a new process to allow you to provide the needed consent remotely for your loved one to receive the vaccination. Please send an email to the Administrator of your community (Joan.Newman@silverado.com) and send it by Thursday, December 17 with the following verbiage:

"As a responsible party, I consent to insurance billing and treatment to receive vaccination for COVID-19."

We will then be attaching your email, inputting your loved one's insurance information, and signing the consent provided by CVS on the clinic's day.
