

SILVERADO BELMONT HILLS COVID-19 UPDATE

February 6, 2021

Dear Family and Friends,

I am excited to share that we had 96% of our residents receive the 1st Pfizer vaccine last Sunday. Other than some mild injection redness, all residents are doing well according to our clinical team. We had over 50% of our associates vaccinated with plans for more to receive their first vaccine at our next clinic, Sunday February 21, 2021. See information below.

Clinic #2 Sunday, February 21, 2021 from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm

This is 2^{nd} vaccine for all residents and associates who received the 1^{st} vaccine on 1/31/21 and anyone who did not receive the first vaccine.

Clinic #3 Sunday, March 14, 2021 from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm

Final vaccine only for 2nd (final shot) for residents and associates.

We continue to follow San Mateo County Public Health, Department of Social Services, and Centers for Disease Control and Silverado home office guidelines. Whichever agency has the strictest protocols, we are required to follow their guidelines. Currently we are testing all residents and associates weekly. Once we have two rounds of all negative tests, we can consider re-opening outdoor visitation. If a resident tests positive for the COVID virus, we are contacting the resident's responsible party.

Many families have asked about visiting inside the community with their loved one, especially if they have completed their vaccinations. I honestly do not have an answer at this time. Silverado home office is definitely reviewing guidelines and will be putting out information when available. There are currently no changes to any agencies visitation protocols. It is frustrating for all of us and I look forward to the day when we can safely open the community for visitors and resume regular daily operations.
