Unfortunately, what has come from the Department of Social Services is confusing messaging that the community linked to the prior license number has closed. Let me assure you that our communities have not closed! Silverado has continued to operate and manage each of these communities in the same way we always have. This change of ownership does not impact operations at the community level. This

computer-generated message from DSS acknowledges the old community license has been closed. This closure is required before activating the new license number. It's unfortunate their system auto-generates this confusing message. We look forward to the day when our county health departments will allow unrestricted family visits. This day is coming closer with every vaccine being administered. Until then, we appreciate your patience.
